Account Financial

Please make sure you have a CURRENT CARD ON FILE and that auto pay is turned ON.

Cash and checks accepted to the front desk (in an envelope, payable to Bliss) before the 5th of each month. Otherwise your card will run, this avoid the need for late fees.

You can log on anytime to view payments, dues, classes, etc. You will also be emailed an invoice before the 5th of each month.

Pick Up & Drop Off Procedure

Curbside route:

There are signs showing you which way to enter/exit for drop off pick up. Please pull all the way forward. If you come more than 5 min early PLEASE FIND A PARKING STALL.

Drop Off instructions:

- **Students 6 & Under** please wait in the main lobby and they will be picked up by their teacher and taken back to their classroom.
- **Students 7 & Up** will meet their teacher in their class room, the first week back the teachers will meet them in the Lobby.

Pick Up instructions

- **Students 6 & Under** will be walked out to the front lobby area, parents can come into the lobby to grab them, or the instructor will help them look for their parents car to pull up
- **Students 7 & Up** will wait outside by the curb, when its too cold they may wait in the main seated lobby area until picked up.

Parents are solely responsible for students after the assigned class time.

Costumes
